1. Beginners' Course

- Kevin Oakes is leaving the club leaving the club one less coach:
 - O Club to fund coaching programme for new coaches.
 - o Oliver to put note on website.
- Need mapping capability that is better at printing Paul to help Steve.
- 'Tone Up Thursday':
 - o Course to help with balance/core training.
 - o Run a course to 'train the trainers'?
- Some Reebok step and weights kit would ideally be acquired.

2. Membership Update

- It was proposed that this be explored further, more detail obtained/generated, and presented to the committee next meeting.
- Committee vote was held: Does the committee feel that we should explore scholarship schemes further?
 - o Quantity of votes obtained: 16
 - o For: 11
 - o Against: 5

8. Kevin Oakes/Bournville College
